By Road:

Entering Portsmouth from exit 12 on the M27, proceed via the M275, until the motorway ends at a roundabout. Continue straight across turning right at the next roundabout. Follow the road over a mini roundabout taking the right hand fork at the second set of traffic lights. Continue straight into Queen Street. The Club can be found towards the end on the left hand side. (See www.royalmaritime.co.uk)

Car Parking

There are a limited number of lockable parking spaces on the Club premises available on a first come first served basis. An NCP is within easy reach, closes at 1900, together with on-street parking in the vicinity.

Limited spaces on site

Residents temporary parking permits, ask at reception (believed to cost £2/24hours)

3 public car parks nearby, be aware of closing times, see the map on last page

By Sail: Gunwharf Quays Marina. Tel: 023 9283 6738 www.gunwharf-quays.com/marina.htm

It is important to book a berth early for your boat at the marina which is half a mile walk away max. See the road map on the last page for route. Cost is currently £3.50 per metre (min £28 for 8m) including electricity, showers etc., state "Member of YOSC Rally" when booking to get discount. Do not forget to call QHM on VHF Ch11 for permission to cross the harbour when at the Ballast Beacon, and to confirm with QHM that a berth has been arranged. Call again for the return passage before leaving Gunwharf Quays for the Ballast Beacon.
