

## YOSC Rally to Island Harbour May 29 ,30 & 31

Our next sailing rally will be to Island Harbour Marina on the Isle of Wight over the May Bank Holiday. Following the pattern set in previous years it promises to be a different kind of rally. Some of the events will be familiar; some are new for this year. Come along, sail to Island Harbour and enjoy the fun. See the plan for the three days.

**Saturday:** Sail to peaceful and picturesque Island Harbour Marina on the Isle of Wight, HW Cowes 1345 BST. In the afternoon take part in a mini fun quiz and also let your artistic talents take over, win a prize by making a collage from locally gathered materials. Baseboards and glue provided. At the end of the afternoon there is a prize to be won by entering and winning the blind rowing competition, it's all good fun. Bring your own DIY portable BBQ and finish the day with BBQ food on the Marina green overlooking the river Medina.

**Sunday:** we will move out of the marina to see & hear some of attractions on the Island. Catch a bus to Newport and visit the Classic Boat Museum, board another bus for a pub lunch at the Woodmans Arms in Wootton Common. Take a train trip, on the IOW Steam Railway and experience an 9 mile round trip, stopping at Haven Street to join in the 1960s event they are holding.

It promises to be good afternoon. From the mini to the mini-skirt, from the Beatles to Jimi Hendrix, and from the Steam Age to the Space Age - the 1960s had it all. Relive the fashions, the music and the icons which began 50 years ago, plus there's music from the 'Five O'Clock Shadows'! There is a café at Haven Street rail station. Bus back to Island Harbour, relax and eat in either the Brassiere (used to be the Bistro) at Island harbour or take a short walk to the Folly.

There will be a few guides to ensure that we stick to the timetable, find the bus stops and catch the right bus.

**Monday:** On Monday morning I will be running the Recycle Regatta Challenge, a scrapheap sailing event to decide who will win the Scrapheap Trophy. Collect some rubbish, build a small sail boat from scrap, sail it down the course to win a prize and an appropriate trophy.

The next bit is easy, sail away from Island Harbour after 1300 BST, HW 1500 BST, arrive home and relax.

All the events promise to be good fun enjoyed by all, whatever your level of participation. Bus passes are accepted on the Island, so

bring yours along if you have one, I have negotiated a group rate on the admission prices for the Boat museum and Steam Railway, the Boat museum will cost £2 and the Steam rail/1960s event will cost £8 per person.
