

1. Entry is by the usual Park Road entrance but this will not be an exit door at any time.
2. Exit is now through the door leading out to Wellington Road and accessed through the passageway between the bar storage area and kitchen.
3. Anyone attending the club is asked to use the sanitising gel dispensers upon entry to and exit from the club and also upon entry to and exit from toilets.
4. Only the toilets either side of the stage will be open. The ones in the entrance area, at Park Road, will remain closed for the time being.
5. The passageway where we usually hang our coats will remain closed for the time being.
6. Screens have been installed at the bar and people are asked to observe the required distance from the bar when ordering drinks, there are sufficient marks to indicate this.
7. Orders of more than a single drink will be provided further down the bar where you will have to collect them. Staff will be collecting empty glasses more frequently than usual. Payment is by contactless card if at all possible.
8. We are asked to refrain from moving the tables and chairs from the positions we find them in. Sufficient seating is available for most circumstances and sufficient space between tables to ensure people can maintain good social distancing. There are numerous signs and boards around the club to remind us all about the importance of this.
9. SSC is not required to comply with the limit on numbers as part of the guidelines because of the amount of space they have within the club, however they ask that people do not stay at the club if in doing so makes it difficult to maintain social distancing.
10. We MUST provide our full contact details when attending the club. The usual YOSC sheet will not be provided so there is a single sheet for name, address, phone number and email and we suggest you take your own pen along to do it. To comply with point 11 below there will be no compromise on this.
11. If anyone becomes unwell with COVID-19 symptoms, within seven days of being at the club please inform Ian Whyteside on 07903 834733, or by using the treasurer mail address, who will pass the information on to SSC. They will then make contact with all persons who were at the club on that evening and comply with the required contact and trace measures which are in place.
